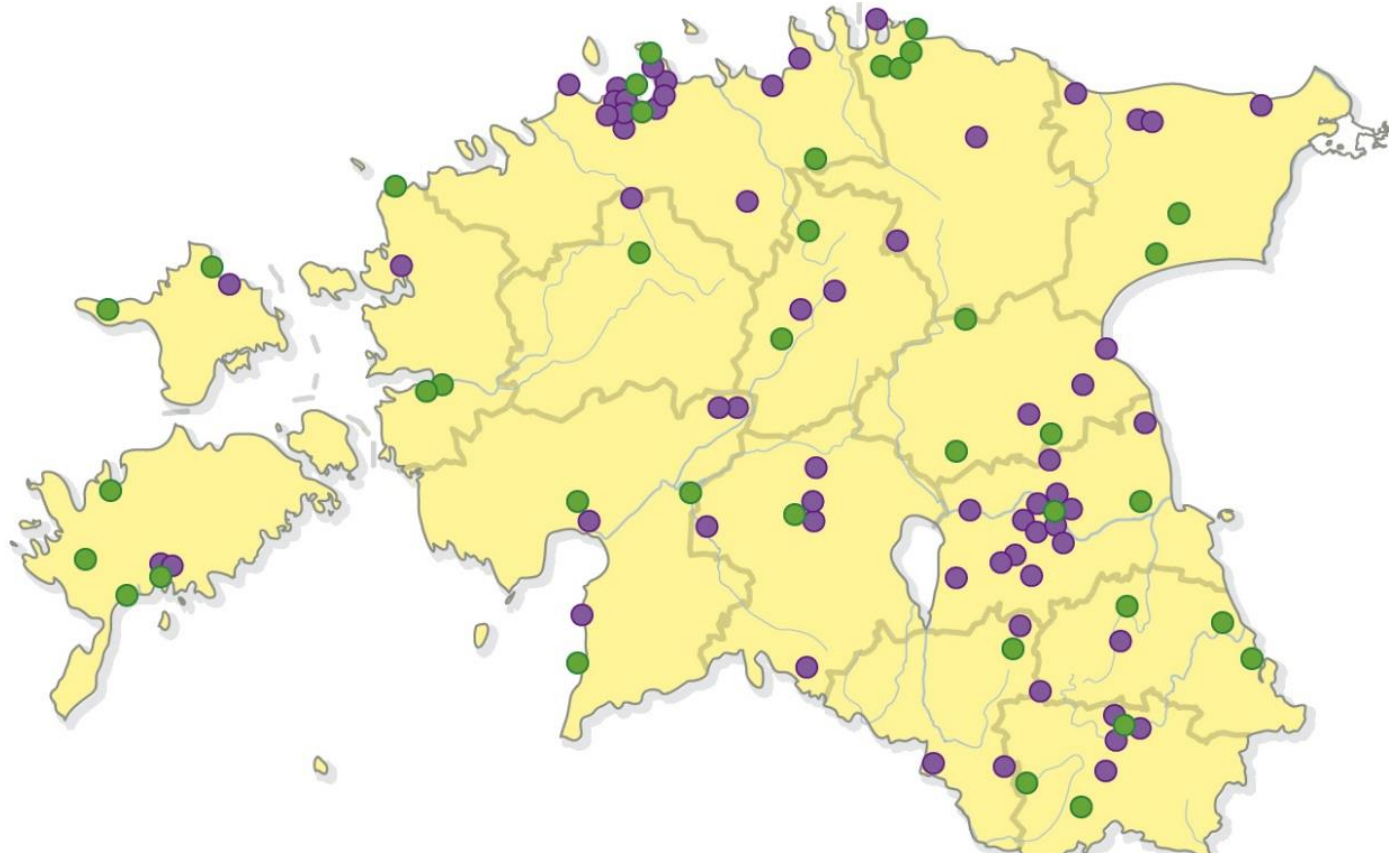

Financing: Environmental Investment Centre

environmental awareness program

- Schools and kindergartens can apply for visits to nature centres via electronic applying system
- Only visiting the programmes that are uploaded in database keskkonnaharidus.ee can be applied for projects.
- The programmes must be connected to state curriculum
- In 2016 nearly 600 projects were financed- totally 3,2 million €
- 70% of the total amount of general school students in Estonia took part in those programmes.
